Creating an account:

- (1) Before using the system, you must create a user account one-time only.
- (2) Go to website at <u>https://proposalcentral.com/</u>
- (3) Select box for applicants: Click here to Login, Register and Apply.

- (4) Select "Click here" to create new account.
- (5) On next screen, complete all required fields noted with an *; then, accept terms/policies.
- (6) When complete, you will receive email with confirmation #. You will need this # only when you log in as a user for first time.
- (7) Return to <u>https://proposalcentral.com/</u> and log in with user ID, password, then on next screen insert your confirmation #.
- (8) The first step in completing your application is to build your profile.
- (9) When you log in, there will be a screen requesting your "Professional Profile." Click on the "Add" link next to Institution and Contact Info."
- (10) Enter NIH on the search string, then select your institute/center; scroll to the bottom and click "Select."
- (11) The next screen begins your professional profile you are NOT required to complete all of these fields! Complete ONLY full name, address, phone/email/fax on the first screen and hit "Next." The next screen will ask for degree information; complete that screen but SKIP the research interests, personal data, and biosketch screens, these are NOT required!
- (12) Be sure to select "save" for any information entered; then, return to the prior page by clicking the "Previous" link and then select link titled "Create New Proposal."
- (13) If you are ready to start the letter of intent, begin at #3 (LOI section) below.

Past account users:

- (1) Go to website at https://proposalcentral.com/
- (2) Under Applicant Log-in, enter in your username and password.
- (3) If you have forgotten your username and/or password, click Forgot your password? and ProposalCentral will email you your account information.
- (4) If you have any problems logging into the site, call the help line at toll-free 800-875-2562

To submit Letter of Intent (LOI):

- (1) If you have already registered in the system as a user, log in at https://proposalcentral.com/
- (2) Click red button on left side titled "Create New Proposal."
- (3) Scroll down (alphabetically) to National Institutes of Health and click on "**Apply Now**" in far-right column. Be sure to apply to the Bench-to-Bedside Program specifically.
- (4) Type in proposal title, select "save", then "next."
- (5) The next screen allows you to give other users access to your Bench-to-Bedside application. This individual must first register with ProposalCentral before you can allow access. If already registered, select name under the "Proposal Access User Selector" section on the bottom of the page. Colleagues may edit the proposal, but the online application MUST BE INITIATED AND SUBMITTED BY THE INTRAMURAL INVESTIGATOR.
- (6) The next screens are self-explanatory remember to always select "save", then "next" to advance.
- (7) You will be asked to validate your letter before submitting it. At this time, the system will check your LOI for any fields that are missing information. Once you have completed all of the fields during the validation process and are prepared to submit your letter, hit "submit" button.
- (8) If you submit your letter before the LOI deadline, you have until the deadline to log back into the system for changes. To edit, un-submit your proposal, make changes, and then, <u>re-submit</u>. NO changes can take place after the deadline.
- (9) PI will receive email re: decision by Scientific Director(s) to approve/reject LOI.
- (10) Once approved, PI may begin submission of full proposal (see Tip Sheet #2 to submit full proposal).
